



## Guidance for Cattle Exhibitors



We are delighted to welcome you back to the show this year. Things will be a little different so please do not expect a normal show. We have worked hard to enable a safe and enjoyable day at Kinross Show for all. New breed signs and info boards have been prepared for the public.

### Before the show

1. Please complete your online application and payment.
2. Confirm BVD Status and scan in or attach a photo of passport.
3. We encourage all to get your Covid-19 vaccination. Please consider doing Lateral flow tests before and after the show.
4. Familiarise yourself with the show layout and routes.
5. Bring cattle passports to the show.

### On arrival at the show

We have additional checks to keep everyone safe. Please arrive early and be patient.

1. Enter by **Gate 1** on the morning of the show
2. You will have your temperature checked, followed by all tickets scanned.
3. Please note. Exhibitor tickets will be issued. **NO TICKET, NO ENTRY**. Please purchase additional tickets from our website <https://www.kinross-show.co.uk>
4. Mr Young and the Gate 1 team will direct you to your class section.
5. Please follow parking instructions exactly because we will be tight for space this year.
6. Unload your Cattle into the relevant pens.
7. There will be ample hand sanitiser at the corner of each block, for your use.

### Exhibiting

1. The Convenor will make themselves known to you and have "holding" passport stickers.
2. The show pens will be further apart, to allow social distancing.
3. The convenor will call sections forward, in turn.
4. The dairy sections will be judged in the MAIN RING this year with an educational commentary. A safe route will be created to the main ring.
5. Please only advance with your stock when instructed to do so.
6. One person per animal, except for young handlers.
7. Please wear a face covering for judging because social distancing may not be possible at all times.
8. The judge will make their decisions, rosettes and prize money will be set at the ring for each class.
9. Please advance one at a time to collect your prize.
10. Please return your stock and yourself to your pen promptly.
11. Use hand sanitiser often.
12. Results will be communicated to the Secretary digitally and posted on the website.
