

Guidance for Clydesdale, Shetland and Highland Horse Exhibitors



We are delighted to welcome you back to the show this year. Things will be a little different so please do not expect a normal show. We have worked hard to enable a safe and enjoyable day at Kinross Show for all. New breed signs and info boards have been prepared for the public.

Before the show

- 1. Please complete your online application and payment.
- 2. Confirm EBAV Status and scan in or attach a photo of passport and vaccination.
- 3. We encourage all exhibitors to get your Covid-19 vaccination. Please consider doing a lateral flow test before and after the show.
- 4. Familiarise yourself with the show layout and routes
- 5. Bring the animals passports to the show in case of Trading Standards inspection.

On arrival at the show

We have additional checks to keep everyone safe. Please arrive early and be patient.

- 1. Enter by **Gate 1** on the morning of the show
- 2. You will have your temperature checked, followed by all tickets scanned.
- 3. Please note, Exhibitor tickets will be issued. **NO TICKET, NO ENTRY**. Please purchase additional tickets from our website https://www.kinross-show.co.uk
- 4. The **Gate 1** team will direct you immediately **left** to your class section.
- 5. Your sections will take place between the Main ring and the Road. Vehicles will be parked as a herring bone pattern and a large central space for exhibiting/judging. The cars then act as a perimeter.
- 6. Please follow parking instructions <u>exactly</u> because we will be tight for space this year.
- 7. Horse boxes will be pointing into the central space to allow ease of unloading/loading.

Exhibiting

- 1. The Convenor will make themselves known to you and have "holding" passport stickers.
- 2. The vehicles will be further apart to allow social distancing.
- 3. The convenor will call sections forward, in turn.
- 4. Please only advance to the central judging area, with your stock when instructed to do so.
- 5. One person per animal, except for young handlers.
- 6. You are responsible for the safe handling of your animal at all times.
- 7. Please wear a face covering for judging because social distancing may not be possible at all times.
- 8. Following the judge's decision, Rosettes and prize money will be set out for each class.
- 9. Please advance one at a time to collect your prize.
- 10. Please return your horse and yourself to the vehicle area promptly.
- 11. Use hand sanitiser often.
- 12. Results will be communicated to the Secretary digitally and posted on the website.
